**The Department's International Employment Services** is part of EURES - European Employment Services Network established by the European Commission to assist the free movement of workers between the EU/ EEA countries. It is responsible for preparing mobile workers interested in coming to Ireland or workers from Ireland who wish to take up employment opportunities in other Member States of the EU/EEA.

### Services provided for migrants:

- **Information and Advice on Living and Working in Ireland.**

Detailed practical information on all aspects of living and working in Ireland is available in 18 languages (English, Czech, Estonian, Greek, Hungarian, Irish, Latvian, Lithuanian, Maltese, Polish, Slovakian, Slovenian, German, French, Portuguese, Spanish, Bulgarian and Romanian). **'Know Before You Go'** information aimed at preparing European job seekers, interested in working in Ireland and other publications on Job Mobility in Europe are available on [www.welfare.ie](http://www.welfare.ie) website and in Intreo/ Employment Offices in Ireland.

- **Information and Advice on search for employment in Europe.**
